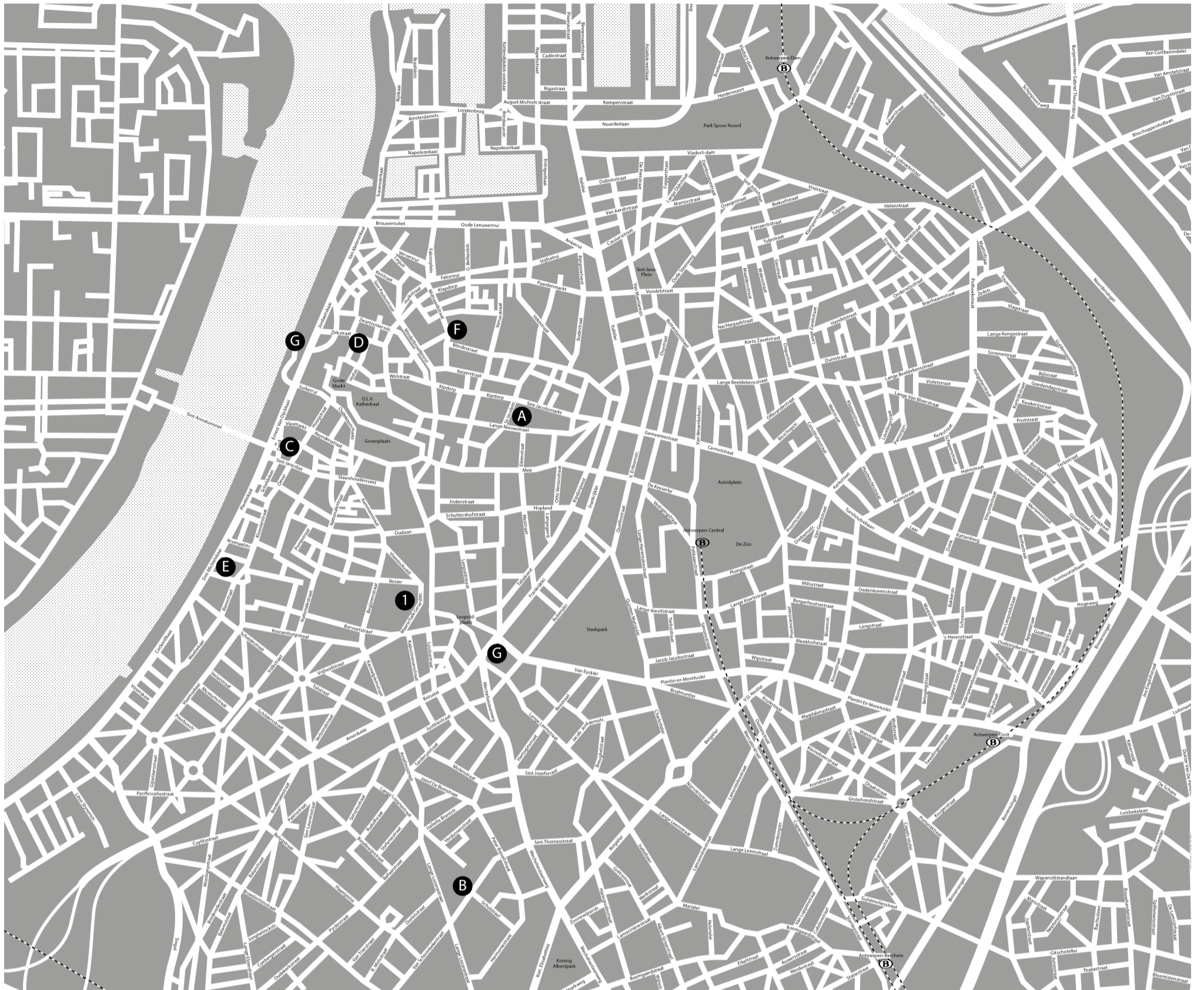


# AAW History Now
