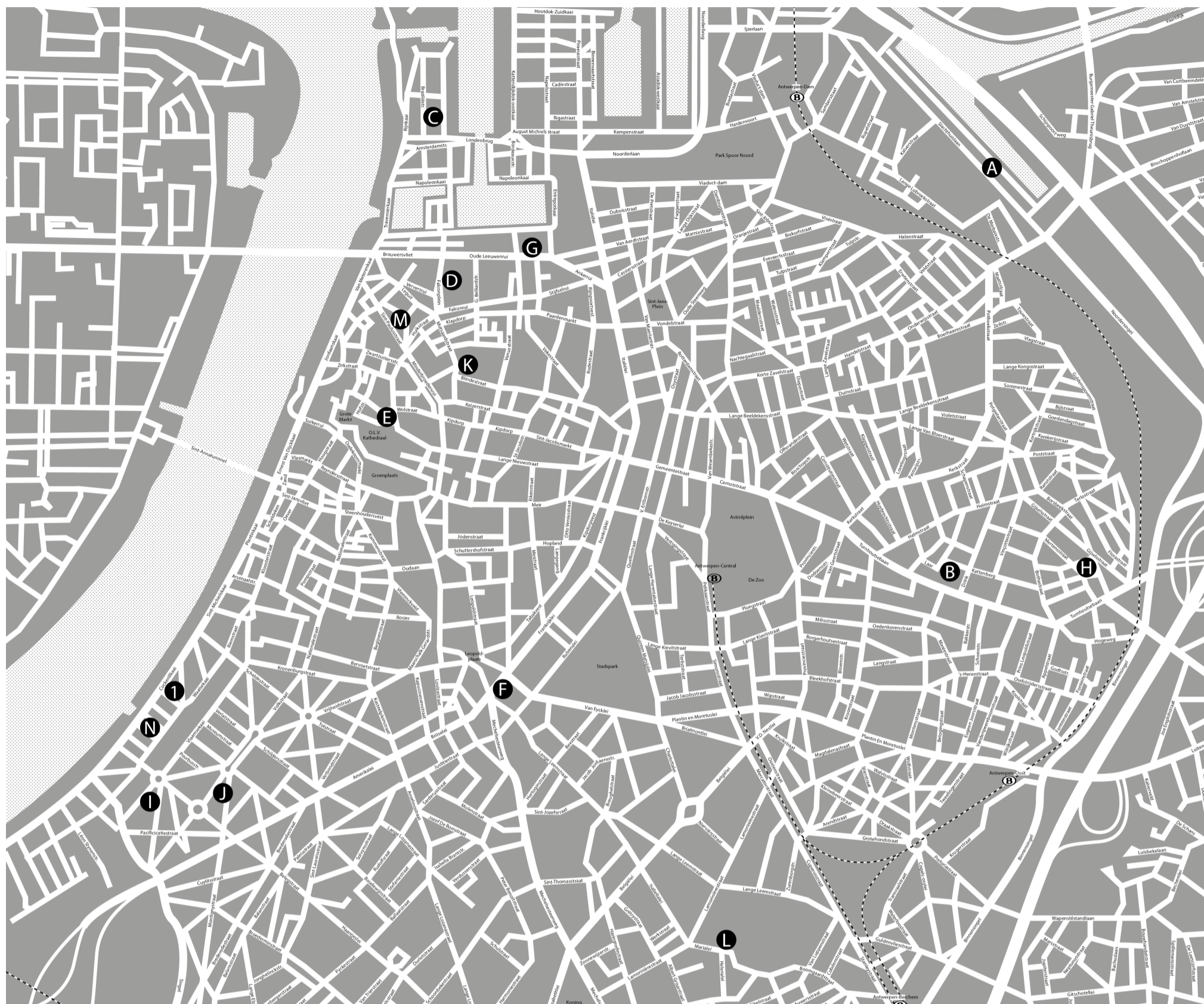


AAW Community
